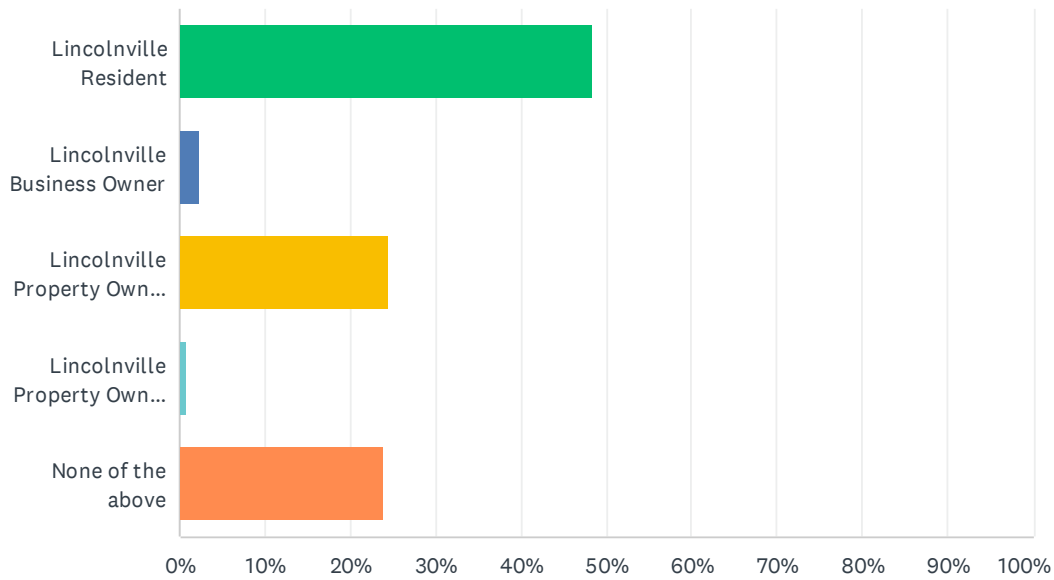


Q1 How would you describe yourself?

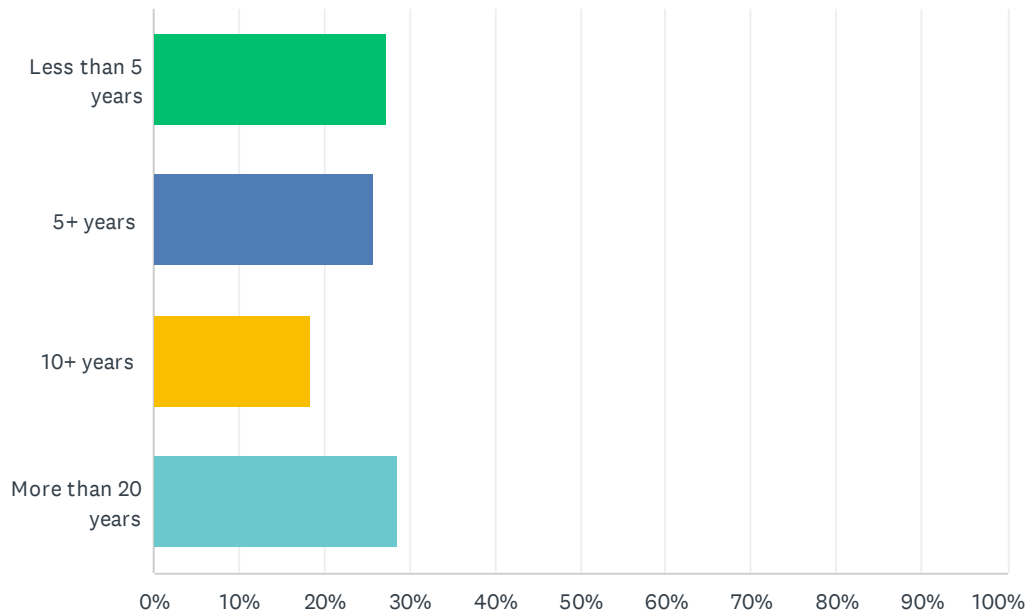

Q3 How long have you lived in or been a stakeholder in Lincolnvilve?

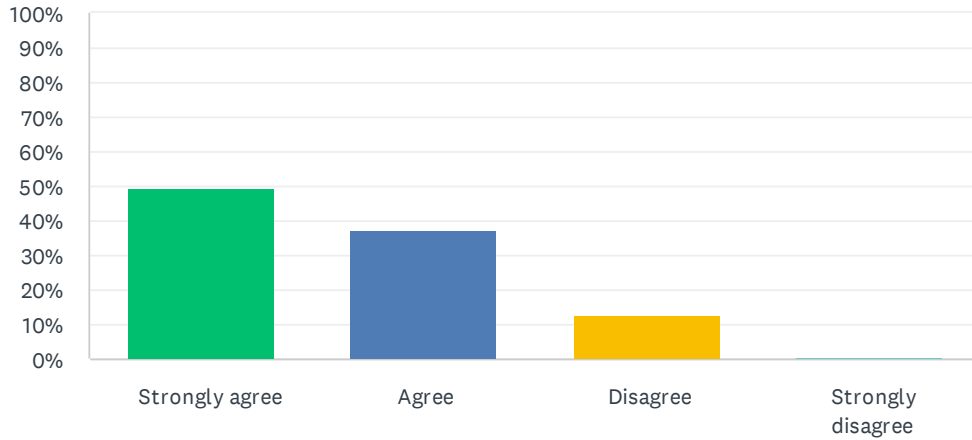

Q4 During your time in Lincolnton, would you agree or disagree that the area has changed architecturally?

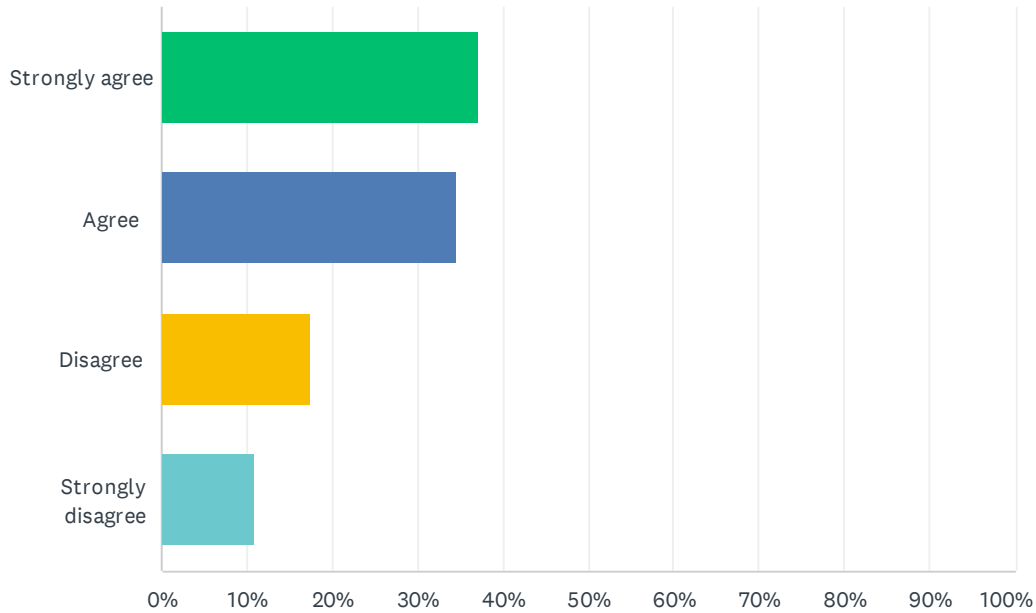

Q5 Do you agree or disagree that Lincolnton could benefit from the implementation of a design standard and/or guideline?

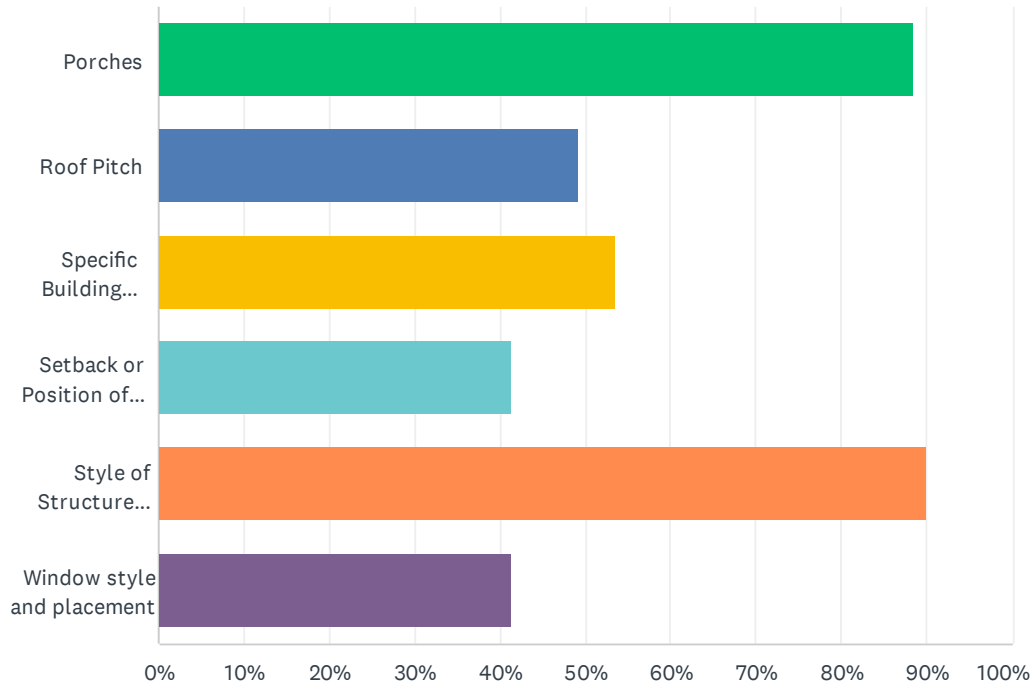

Q6 From the list below, what would you consider historic features of Lincolnton structures or homes? (please select all that apply)

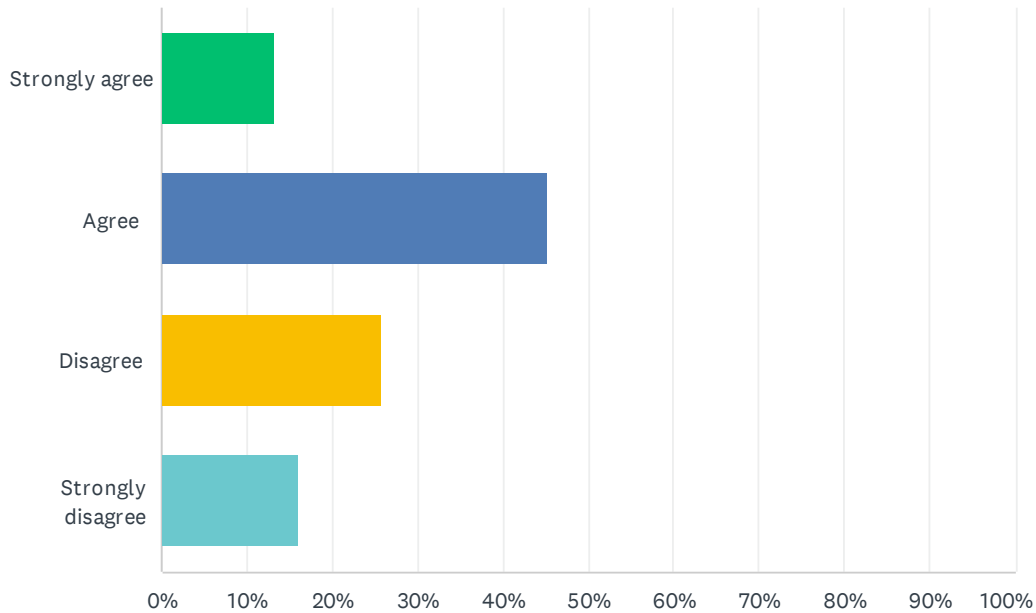

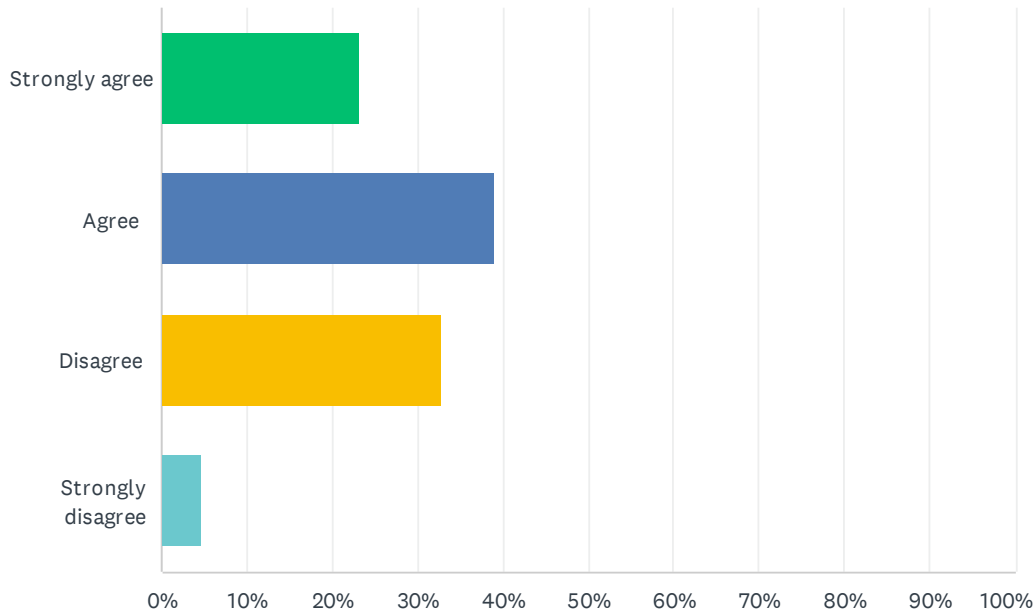

Q8 As a current resident or stakeholder, do you agree or disagree that home repair costs will be a challenge if design standards and/or guidelines are implemented?

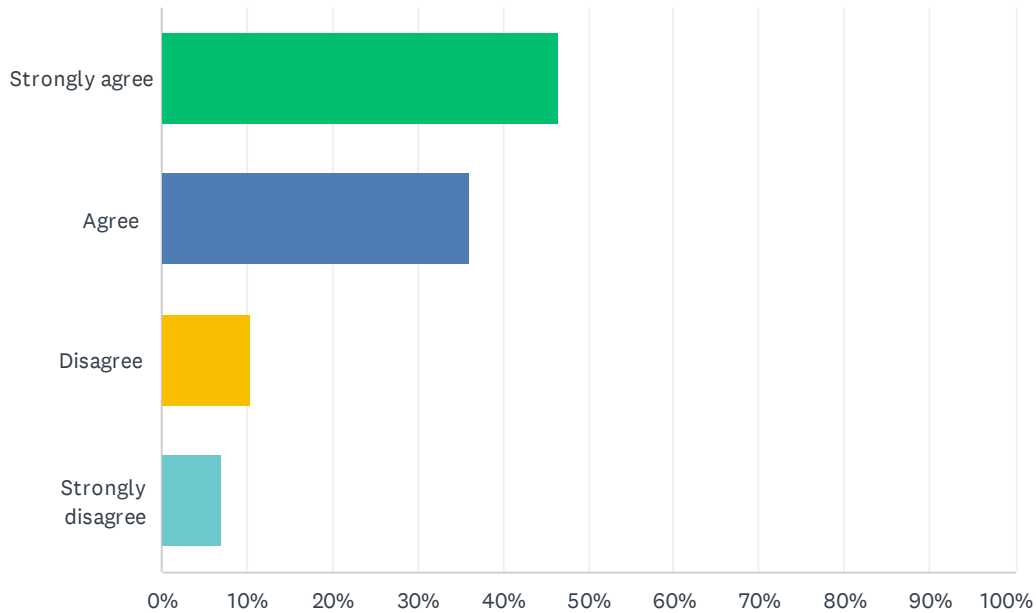

Q9 Do you agree or disagree that architectural guidelines or standards should address the scale or size of newly constructed structures in Lincolnton?

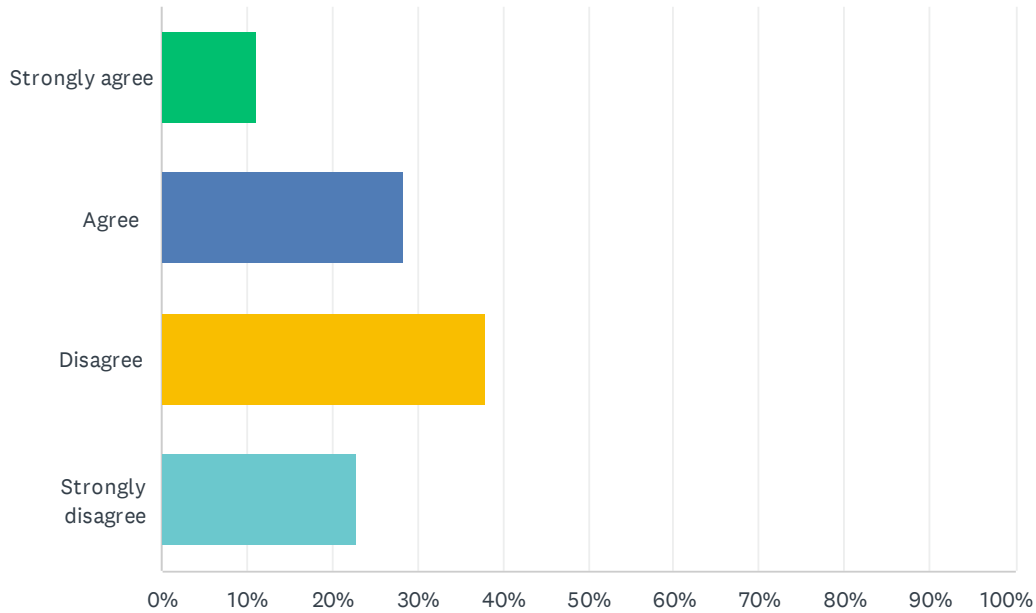

Q10 Do you agree or disagree that architectural design standards or guidelines should address the exterior color of historic structures?

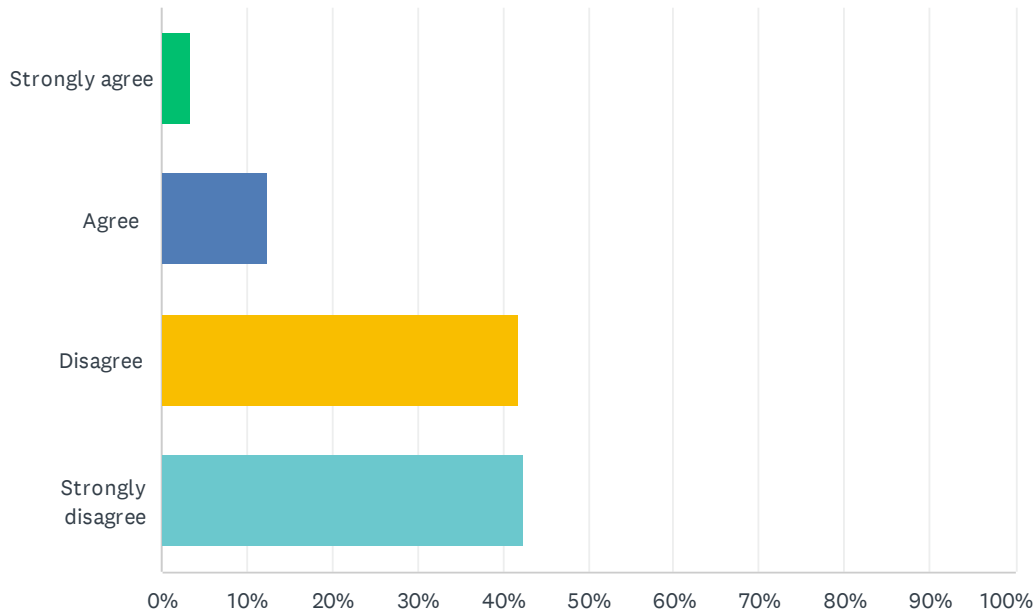

Q11 Do you agree or disagree that if a historic structure is demolished it should be replaced with a structure exhibiting more modern concepts, features, and materials?

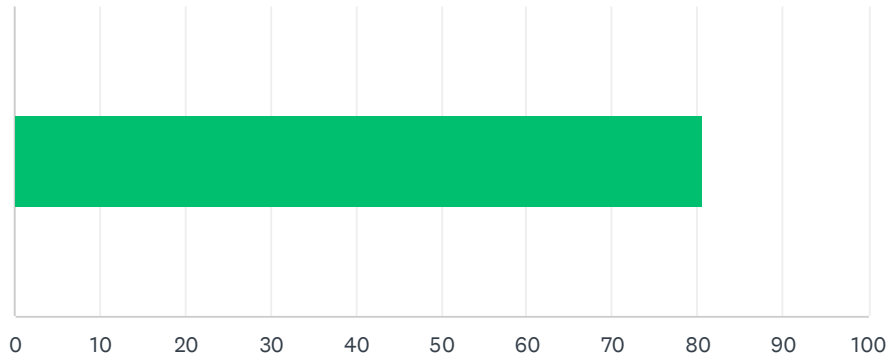

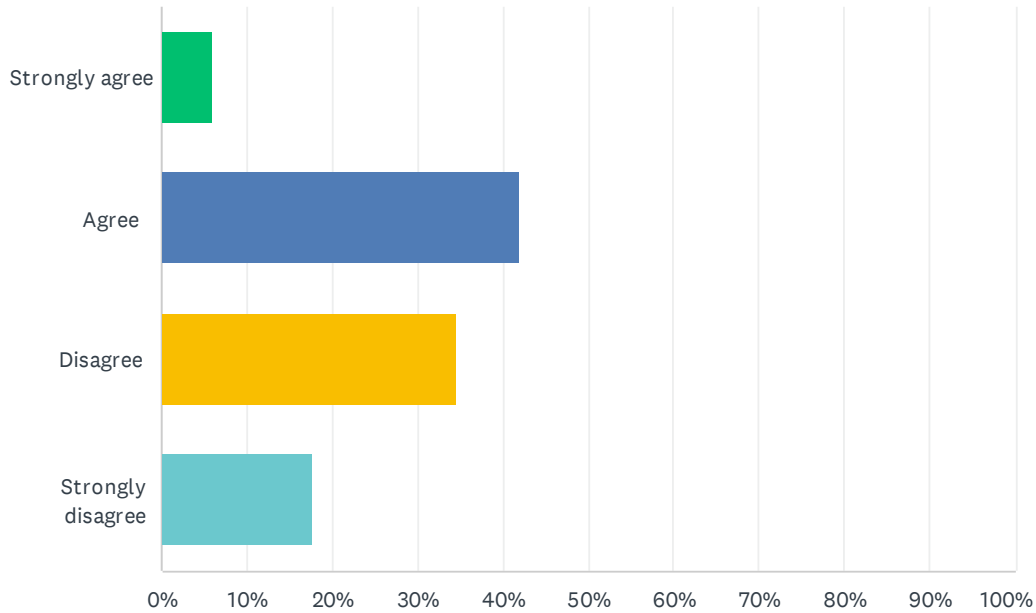

Q13 Do you agree or disagree that the structure pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

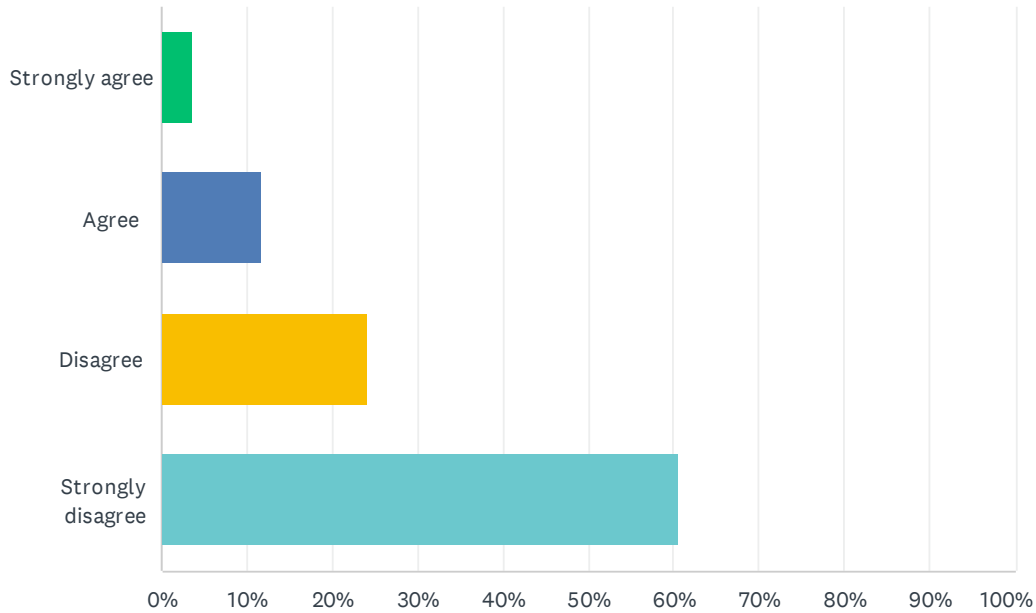

Q14 Do you agree or disagree that the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

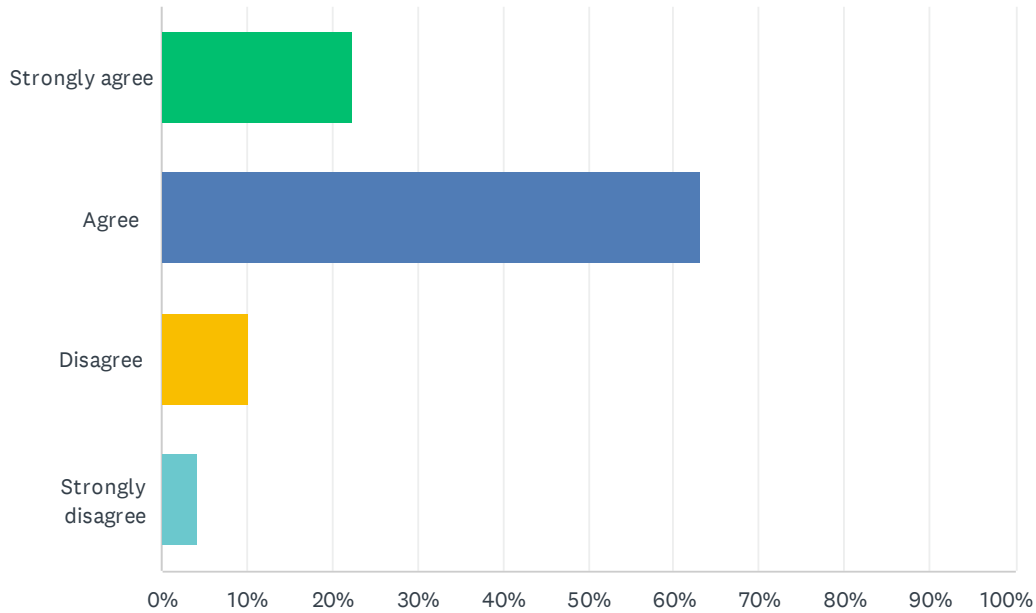

Q15 Do you agree or disagree that the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

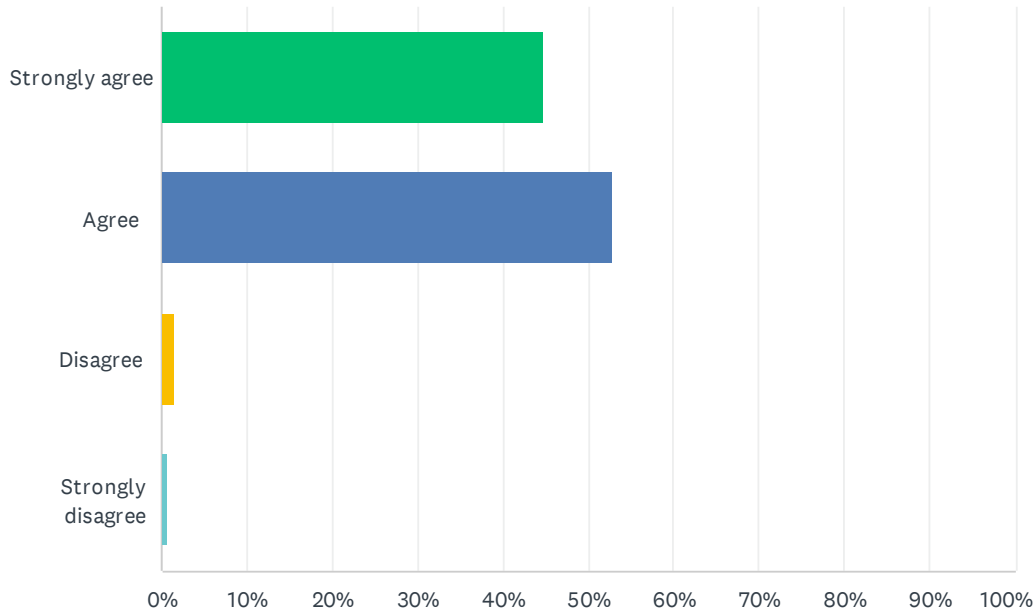

Q16 Do you agree or disagree that the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

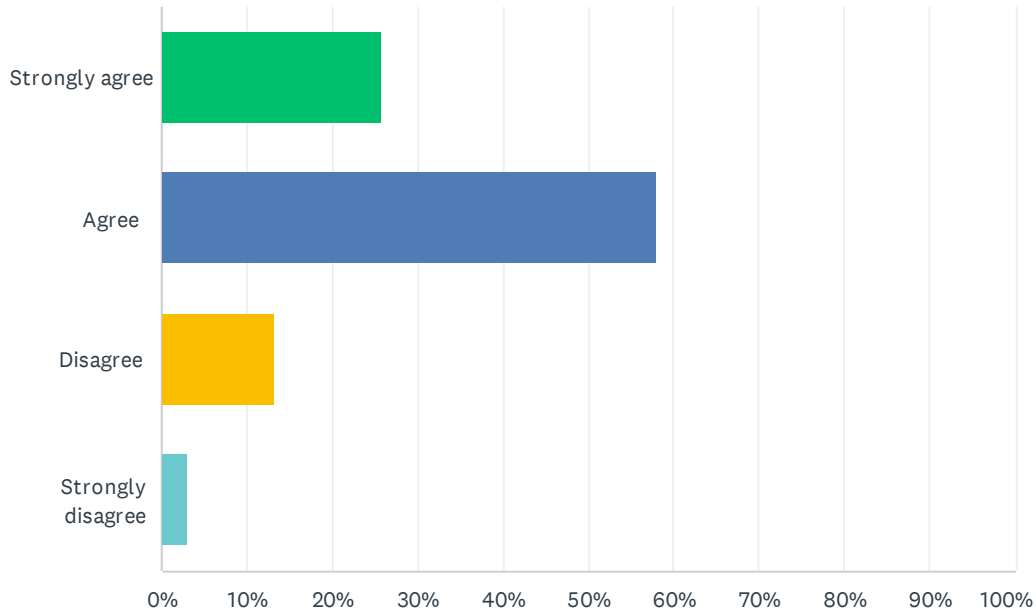

Q17 Do you agree or disagree that the roof pitch on the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

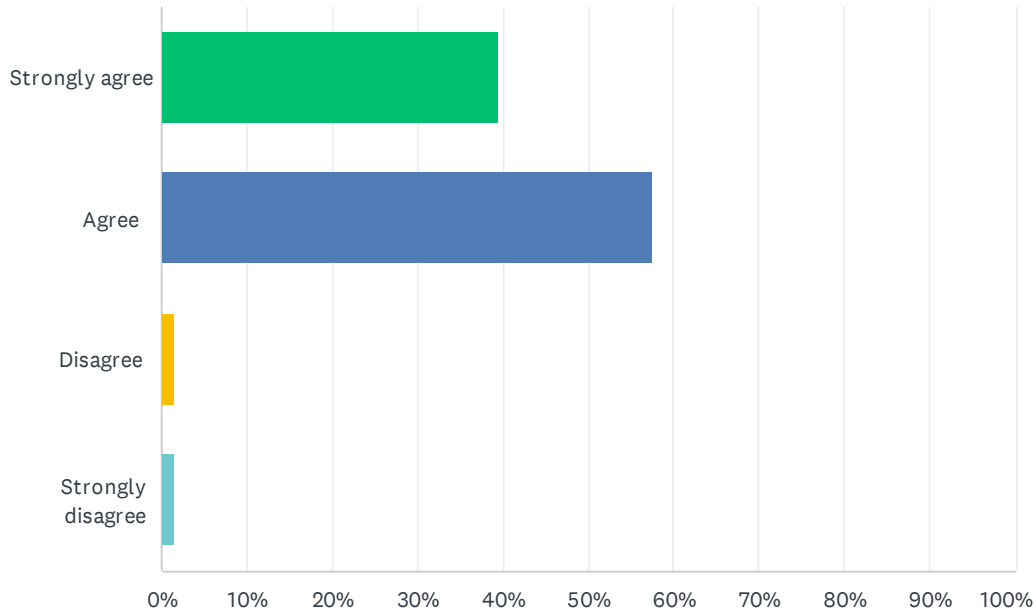

Q18 Do you agree or disagree that the porch on the house pictured above is compatible with the historic character of the Lincolnton area?

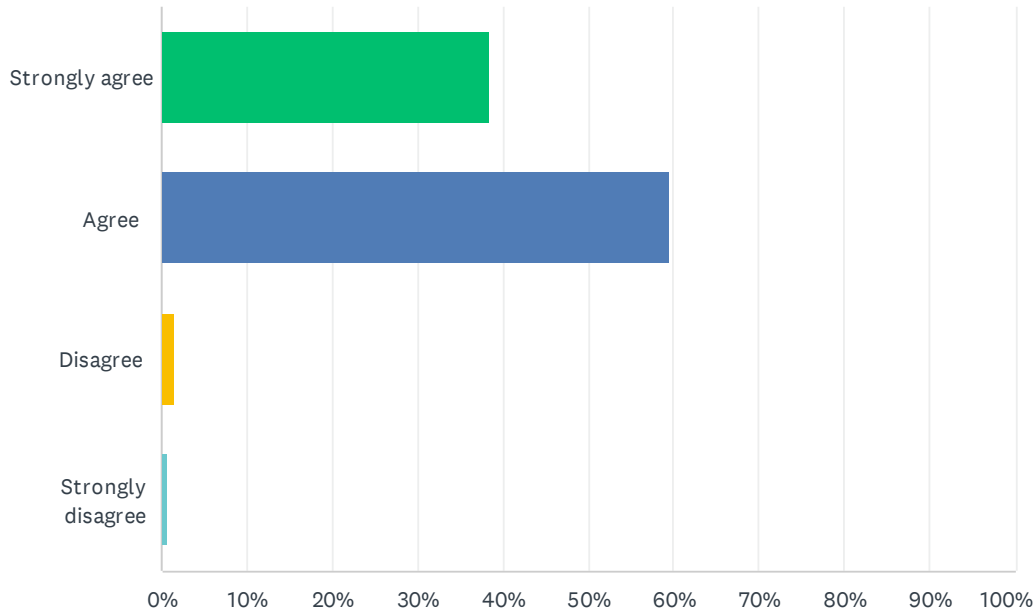

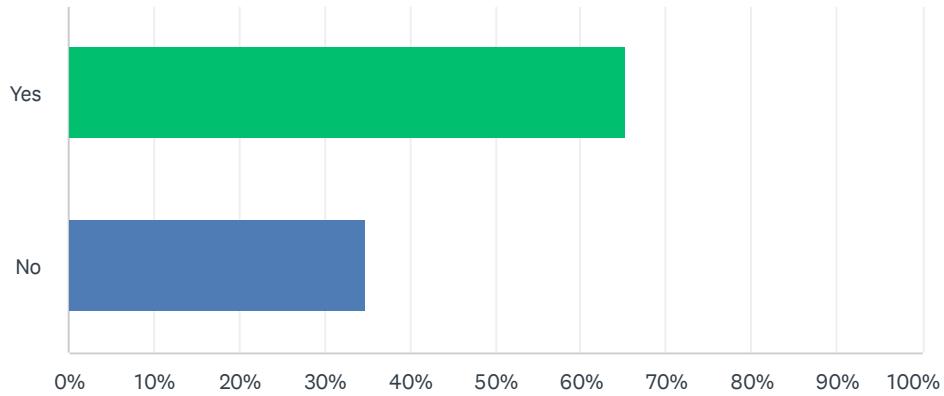
